NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the Gallatin County Willow Creek Sewer District, Gallatin County, Montana, (the "District") will meet on October 23, 2024, at 6:30 p.m., at the Willow Creek School, Willow Creek, Montana, for the purpose of holding a public hearing on increasing wastewater rates for the District. The District needs additional funds to meet its current operation and maintenance expenses.

The District currently imposes a monthly rate of \$39.84 per user for operation of the system. The District also charges a monthly maintenance only fee of \$6.80. The new monthly operation cost rate for the Wastewater System is proposed to be \$60.00 per user. The new monthly maintenance only fee for the Wastewater System is proposed to be \$10.00 per month/user.

The new rates are anticipated to begin November 1, 2024. All persons who own property in the District and customers of the District may appear and be heard at the time and place of the hearing.
